Entries will be processed on a first come, first served basis as the show is limited to 8 hours of judging per day. Entries will not be considered received until all required documentation and full payment is received.

Directions to Foxleigh Riding Stables: Off Hwy 6 turn East onto the Foxleigh Grid. Turn North on the first grid, it is the first property on the left. In google maps it will show up as Foxleigh Riding Stable, 50.61808317513672, -104.59457127198858.

Heritage, Para Equestrian and Prairie Cup approved classes will count towards year end awards. Please ensure your SHF membership is current and that you have nominated if you are interested in accumulating points for the awards. To qualify for Heritage Provincial Finals September 2024, you must have attended a minimum of two Heritage Circuit shows and have placed in the top 5 in a division to be eligible to participate in any class within that division.

General Rules:

Participants are requested to read all rules governing this show. For English classes, the Saskatchewan Horse Federation rules will apply and for Western classes, the WSDAC rules will apply.

Proof of a negative coggins test within the last 180 days and proof of Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 (Rhino) vaccination within the last 180 days are required. Horses not presenting proof of Vaccinations and/or negative Coggins within the last 6 months will not be allowed to unload. Foxleigh Riding Stable is a coggins A facility.

All English Dressage riders **MUST** wear an approved ASTM or SEI approved helmet at all times while mounted on show grounds, as required by the Saskatchewan Horse Federation.

In accordance with WSDAC attire rule 6.01b, all riders Western Dressage riders are required to wear an approved helmet while mounted by the show organizers.

Show Rules:

All riders must be current members of the Saskatchewan Horse Federation.

Numbers must be worn by all horses. This includes hand-walking while on property and while in the competition ring. Numbers are available to rent from the show office, please indicate on the entry form if you will be renting a number.

Schooling is permitted in designated areas only. Lunging is not permitted.

In the Dressage and Western Dressage Divisions: A horse/rider combination may only compete in only 2 consecutive levels, and a horse may compete in a maximum of 4 tests per day. This includes English & Western Dressage tests combined.

A participant is considered to be a certain age until the end of the calendar year in which they turn that age. So, a rider would remain a Junior until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 18.

All English Dressage classes are being run as open with no age designations.

Western Dressage classes will be run as open unless the number of entries warrants splitting of classes by division.

Ride times will be assigned and published on the RDDA Facebook page and Website.

It is the responsibility of riders to present themselves at the in-gate promptly at their assigned ride times. Riders who do not arrive on time will be eliminated from the class and forfeit their entry fees.

Abuse or inhumane treatment of horses, as well as unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Show management reserves the right to excuse those who are witnessed to commit such offenses.

WSDAC tests and rules will be followed for these tests. In accordance with WSDAC attire rule 6.01b, all riders are required to wear a helmet by the show organizers.

Depending on entries and at the discretion of the show committee, Introductory, Training, and WSDAC Basic and Level 1 classes may be run in the 20 x 40 arena. All other classes will be run in the 20 x 60 arena.

The judge may not be directly approached. Any issues shall be taken to the show committee.

Readers will not be provided. Riders must arrange their own reader.

Hors concurs tests are permitted. The test fee remains the same.

The gate may or may not be closed during the tests with the only possible exception being the para tests if deemed necessary.

Placings:

Class placings will not be split for junior and senior riders.

All scores in dressage tests are calculated to the third decimal. Ribbons will be awarded to 6th place.

English Dressage:

When only one horse in a class, ribbons will be awarded with the following percentages:

First: 60% or higher;

Second: 57% to 59.999%;

Third: 54% to 56.999%;

Fourth: 51% to 53.999%

Western Dressage:

WSDAC rules will apply for scoring and placings at the show, with the exception of results for Heritage Circuit where SHF rules will apply.

Liability:

It is to be understood that neither Foxleigh Riding Stables, the Regina District Dressage Association, the SHF, WSDAC, the show committee, judge, volunteers, or show manager shall be in any way liable for any accident, injury, damage or loss that may happen, from any cause or circumstances whatsoever, to competitors or anyone on the ground during the competition or to any animal or property brought on show grounds or for any loss, claim, matter, circumstance or event in connection with or arising out of or attributable to the show or any journey to and from the show.

Release of Liability form must be signed by all riders or guardians and included with show entry form in order for entries to be processed.

Facility:

There will be limited stabling available for this show. Haul in entries are subject to a \$15 haul in fee, which is payable to the Facility Manager upon arrival to the site.

Tying to your trailer is permitted. Horse cannot to be left unattended will tied to a trailer.

Dogs are **not** allowed on site.
